DOKOKA Contact Less Check-in Mobile Application enables users to securely check in and out of hotels, restaurants, stores, offices, tour venues and transportation to provide contact tracing and personalized alert features to safely reopen Hawaii's businesses.

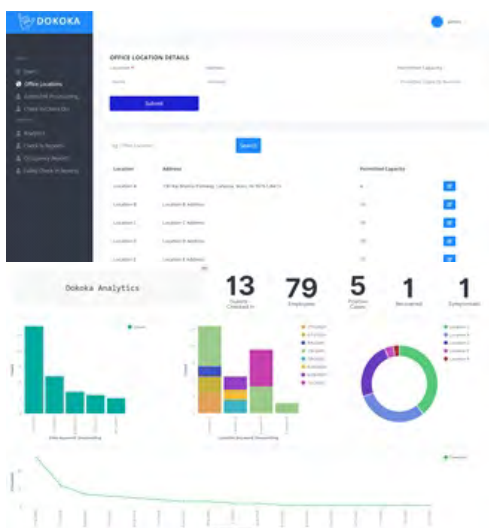
Employees and Visitors of Restaurants

- Employees and visitors will utilize the mobile application to register once and utilize their system assigned unique QR Code to check in and check out of facilities.
- Restaurants and other businesses can display the Mobile App as a QR code near to the front door and visitors can scan the QR code to download the App and check-in. They should also be able to download from app store and register.
- Employees will also be required to report their daily health status as via the mobile application.


Restaurants and Businesses

- Businesses will utilize the mobile app as a scanning device at entry/exit points in their location.
- Administrators will also have access to the Dokoka administration portal. It consolidates check-in information from all devices and provides reporting capabilities that enable reporting to Health authorities and contact tracing in the event of a COVID outbreak.
- The portal also allows the administrator to manage the number of people at the office at any given time.




DOKOKA Employee Mobile App
